Complete physical exams include: vision and hearing screening; developmental screening; height and weight with body mass index; lead, anemia, urine and cholesterol screening; diagnostic tests such as rapid strep screens and any necessary outside laboratory screening tests and referrals.

School-Based Health Care

Our Nurse Practitioners dedicate one day each week in partnering schools to provide health care services while working with your child's school nurse.

Telehealth Available!

If your child becomes ill at school, a Nurse Practitioner from our office works with your school nurse to examine and treat your child using Telehealth technology without ever leaving the school.

These services are available at partnering Knox County schools and change each year depending on need. Check with your child's school to know if these services are available to you! We will seek your permission before all treatment.
